



## **Royal Mid-Surrey Golf Club Dress Code**

We ask that all visitors, members and their guests take a pride in their appearance and above-all that clothing should be clean and tidy.

All players are requested to wear appropriate golf attire on the courses.

Visitors, members and their guests may wear smart, clean, dry, casual dress in the clubhouse. Tailored shorts and soft-spike golf shoes may be worn throughout the ground floor, but not upstairs.

For the avoidance of doubt, whilst smart jeans of any colour may be worn on the ground floor of the clubhouse, terrace and practice putting green, blue denim is not appropriate for the upstairs bar and dining rooms, on the golf courses or other practice areas. Tracksuits and flip-flops are not appropriate in any part of the courses, practice grounds or clubhouse (other than the changing rooms).

Typically, the dress code upstairs in the clubhouse will be smart-casual, but specific dress codes may apply for designated events, eg. black tie dinners, or informal club suppers, as advertised.

Please use the locker rooms whenever changing clothes or shoes rather than doing so in the car park.
