

# J.H. TAYLOR COURSE LOCAL RULES

## 1. Out of Bounds (Rule 18-2)

Beyond any fence bounding the course. Beyond the fence, the line of white posts and the white line surrounding the Spinney at the 10th and 12th holes. Beyond the fence or the line of white posts surrounding the Observatory enclosure at the 12th, 13th and 14th holes.

## 2. No Play Zones (Rule 17-1)

To the left of the 12th fairway and left of the 18th fairway (the driving range) is a No Play Zone. This area is marked with red posts with green tops. Relief must be taken under a one shot penalty. Please ensure you take this relief within the designated drop zones. To the right of the 13th hole and right of the 14th hole (the short game area) is also a No Play Zone. This area is marked with red posts with green tops. Relief must be taken under a one shot penalty. Please ensure you take this relief within the designated drop zones.

## 3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16-1)

All artificially surfaced roads and paths on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed. Note: The area two club-lengths either side of the metalled road crossing the course at the 12th and 18th holes is deemed to be part of the road.

## 4. Fixed Sprinkler Heads

### Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Green (Rule 16-1)

Relief from interference by an immovable obstruction may be taken under Rule 16.1. The player also has the extra options to take relief when such immovable obstructions are close to the putting green and on the line of play:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16-1b if an immovable obstruction is:

- On the line of play, and is;
- Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and
- Within two club-lengths of the ball

Exception – No Relief If Line of Play Clearly Unreasonable. There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.

## 5. Protection of Young Trees

Protection of young trees identified by a stake. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 16-1b. This area is classed as a No Play Zone (Rule 16.1f). The ball may be cleaned when lifted under this Local Rule.

## 6. Health & Safety

Green Staff have priority on the course. If in range of your shot, please wait until either they are clear or aware of your intentions to play.

## 7. Dangerous Weather Conditions

A suspension of play for a dangerous situation will be signalled by the sound of the klaxon. See Rule 5-7b. Under Rule 5-7a, a player is entitled to discontinue play if they believe there is a danger from lightning. This applies equally to formal Club competitions and friendly golf regardless of whether or not the klaxon has been sounded.

## 8. Ground Under Repair

A player may take relief without penalty from any area identified as GUR by being contained within a white line. Relief must be taken from any area identified as GUR by being contained within a blue line or by a sign to the effect that the area is a No Play Zone.
