



RMSGC Dress Code Policy

Royal Mid -Surrey Golf Club aims to balance the dress code traditions of a royal club and also the emerging fashion trends in professional golf attire. To this end, this policy provides guidance to members, their guests and visitors.

Golf clothing that can be found in most professional shops should be worn, including tailored shorts with either long or short socks. Clean, soft spiked golf shoes may be worn in all areas of the clubhouse ground floor.

The following attire is not considered to be appropriate at Royal Mid-Surrey

- Tee-shirts, football/rugby shirts (or similar)
- Fitness attire (track suits, gym shorts, halter or 'strap' tops) (except for classes).
- Cargo trousers/shorts with external pockets, torn or frayed clothing .
- Denim jeans on the golf courses.
- Sandals for men or 'flip flops'.
- Baseball caps worn with the brim facing backwards, hats in the clubhouse (except for religious head coverings).
- Wet, muddy or waterproof clothing in the clubhouse post playing golf (excluding locker rooms).

Smart casual attire (excluding shorts and golf shoes) unless otherwise specified for a function.
